About Kathy Warren's Camps (from Kathy's web site)

"These camps are run according to a schedule, it will not matter where you are in your training. If this is a first time camp you all will start from the beginning. Showing the proper way to start a dog and how to gradually work up to the complete dog. I train strictly with the dogs natural ability and do not believe in mechanical training methods. Anybody can train a dog to get up, get down, go left, and go right but to do this while working with the dog's natural instincts and to maintain and improve on these instincts is how I do it." " We work dogs and make and watch tape all day. This is a very intensive three day handler camp." **NOTE!** this camp is sheep only.

NOTE! HANDLERS with the same dog and AUDITORS MUST ATTEND ALL THREE DAYS

This camp is open to all ASCNE members and their Australian Shepherds first, if not filled we will then take non-members. Completed entries must be in my hands by 5:00 PM on July 31,2004. Accepted entries will be determined by drawing on August 1st Handler entries will be determined first then auditors. (A waiting list will also be decided.) All applicants will be notified by e-mail or telephone (if no e-mail) of the results of the drawing. Accepted entries will need to have a check in my hands by August 18th or lose your spot!

Please do not send check with entry. Once your status is determined and you are notified payment will be required. Accepted entries unpaid by August 19th will relinquish participation to the waiting list. Please make checks payable to ASCNE

Directions from the East: Mass Pike /Exit 9 to Rt. 20 W. Follow Rt. 20 for 2-3 miles to Rt. 148 N (right). Travel 148 to Rt 9 W (left). Take first left after junction of 67 South. Old Warren Road (near Uncle Sam's Pizza). Travel 1.8 miles to log cabin, set back on left.

Directions from the West: Mass. Pike /Exit 8. Right after toll booth to first light. Left at light and follow Rt. 20 E to Rt. 67 N. Follow 67 for 8.8 miles into downtown Warren. Take left between Tebo's Variety and Spencer Savings Bank, Old West Brookfield Road. Follow for 0.8 miles to second house on right after high school.
