<u>Registration &</u> All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered.

Tracking Effective January 1, 2004: All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or and ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. Lodging Accommodations That Accept Well Behaved Dogs, please confirm when calling **SOME MOTEL COURTESIES TO OBSERVE:**

- Cover the motel's bedding with a sheet, whether or not you think your dog will get on the bed.
- If you crate your dog, please bring a towel to put under the crate to keep marks off the rug. Bring a towel to put under your dog's food dish.
- Make every effort to have your dog free of fleas BEFORE arriving.
- All poop must be picked up, bagged, and disposed of properly by the dog's handler. The Event Committee will excuse competitors who fail to pick up after their dogs at the test site or the motel.

• Don't leave your dog unattended. If you must leave, take them with you. **Days Inn**, Raynham MA will take dogs. This is at exit 6 off of Rte 495, about 8 miles from show site. 508-824-8647 Tell them you are with the ASCNE dog show. **Red Roof Inn**, 60 Forbes Blvd., Mansfield, MA. Pet friendly. Right off Rte. 95 & 495, 11 miles from show site. 508-359-2323. Tell them you are with the ASCNE dog show.

Directions From the North: Exit 9 (Bay St.) Take a Right off Exit and an immediate Right into the Myles Standish Industrial Park. Follow Myles Standish Blvd. (approximately 2 miles) to the last left in the Park, John Hancock Rd. Silvercity Canine Training Center is located 1 mile on the left.

From 495 South: Exit 9 (Bay St) Take a Left off the Exit and a Right into the Park. Follow Myles Standish Blvd. (approximately 2 miles) to the last left in the Park, John Hancock Rd. Silvercity Canine Training Center is located 1 mile on the left.
