Affiliate Report-Carol Landry

For the first time in years ASCA has reported a positive net for 2009, and for the first time since 2004, the 2009 National Specialty expenses were less than the sponsorships and entry fees.

A new mission statement was approved and reads as follows:

"The Australian Shepherd Club of America is dedicated to maintaining the integrity of its registry and to preserving and promoting the Australian Shepherd as an intelligent working dog with strong herding instinct."

In the July/August Aussie Times on page 31 is a side by side comparison of the effective ASCA breed standard against 2 different drafts (2008 BSRC and 2010 BoD). I urge all members to take the time to read these and send input to the ASCA Executive Secretary at executive.secretary@asca.org.

Committee reports:

Agility- Some motions that were approved of interest are:

One that defines who, when and how trial results can be changed and emphasizes that clubs may not change results once the trial is completed.

A modification on teeter requirements for safety reasons.

Clarification on when the gamble starts (when the dog performs the first obstacle of the gamble correctly).

A modification on start and finish line requirements adding a minimum distance (30-40 feet on Elite and Open, 40-50 feet for Novice, with a preference of 50 feet for all levels) between them. This will allow ample room for one dog to set up while the other dog completes the course.

Specifying what type of equipment must be present on a gamble course.

A clarification on how many challenges could appear in each level of the gamblers courses.

A change in the timeline for which clubs have to sanction events.

Documentation of the placements in gamblers (the most points gathered regardless of making the gamble).

Conformation-

The Conformation committee is working on redrafting new requirements for the Non-Regular Breeder judge applicant.

DNA- They thank the membership for getting their dogs DNA'ed in a timely manner and they have been busy reviewing current rules and updating them.

Education, Hall of Fame, Legislative, MVA, Nationals & Strategic Planning- No report in last 2 issues of Times.

Health and Genetics- A substantial donation was made to ASCA earmarked for Aussie rescue and health research. Progress has been made on several important proposals going forward to the ASCA Foundation for approval.

Juniors- They are still hard at work reviewing their rulebook and finalizing their activities to be held during Nationals week in Texas.

Obedience- The chapter on Finals rules has been rewritten with the excellent help of our own Robin Goodman and it clarifies several confusing points. Be sure to check it out when the new June 2010 rulebook is available. A motion was

passed to allow the use of colored dumbbells. Other motions dealt with the amount of time allowed for handlers to continue to compete at certain levels and the penalties involved if they go beyond the deadlines, and clarification on earning titles before moving on to the next level. Of particular interest is a project involving the Group stay exercises. There is a poll on page 40 of the latest Aussie Times that they would like the membership to complete and send in.

Rally- Up and going! They have set up a Yahoo group for ASCA Rally at ASCA-Rally@yahoogroups.com. They also urge anyone with questions about hosting a Trial, building courses, applying to judge or about the program, to contact them.

Stockdog- They have been tweaking some of the details on Course C (handler's line distance, size of arena, chute placement, points earned for Finals). They are exploring options for improving the finals and would appreciate input.

Tracking- They are updating their Regs and also want to know what they can do to help the Affiliate Clubs hold Tracking Tests.

Affiliate report motioned to be accepted as read by Valarie Jakubowski and seconded by Dottie Duclos-So Voted.

Library Report-Gull Gullicksen

Gull brought a small selection from the library today and will also bring a small selection to each event.

There was a question about having a Library list placed on the website. If anyone wants something specific, please contact Gull. There was also discussion about purchasing back issues to current of the Annual Report. The library is allotted \$400. a year for purchases so this will be looked into.

All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered. *Effective January 1, 2004:* All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or and ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. From Rt. 95 South of Attleboro - Take Exit 2A (Newport Ave.) to the 2nd light. Take that left onto Benefit St. At the next light bear left onto Central Ave. to the end. Take a left onto Rt. 152 (Newman Ave.) Go ½ mile and take a left onto Pond St. Watch for the Orion Industrial Park on your left (2/10 mile). Turn into the park.
