Affiliate Report: Pauli Haggis presented the Affiliate Report:

The following motions have been passed by the ASCA BOD and will be indoctrinated into the rule books to be published on June 1, 2016.

AGILITY

GAMBLERS The current rule regarding the distance to the gamble line reads "two of the four gamble obstacles in sequence are to be placed at the minimum distance from the gamble line." This will change to "any two obstacles in the gamble will be placed a minimum distance from the gamble line."

TRANSFER OF AGILITY POINTS EARNED With the termination of the Veteran Handler Division, a clarification was needed on how points earned in one division would be treated for those dogs moving to a new division. A competitor earning points in one championship division will have points earned transferred to a new division. ie: if a dog has earned points in Vets, then moves to the standard division it can keep those points toward a title. The title awarded will reflect the number of points earned in the respective divisions. A dog needs 30 points in the Regular class to earn a title. If that dog earns 20 points as a vet, then 10 in standard, the title earned would be for Regular vet. In jumpers or Gamblers where a dog needs 20 points for a title, the title will reflect the last 10 points earned (10 points as a vet then 10 in standard would get a standard title). The outstanding and superior titles would be similarly tallied.

OBEDIENCE

The Graduate Novice Optional Titling Class will be offered as a new titling class. The wording in the new rule book will include "Optional Titling class" as well as "Regular division" in reference to Titles-Trial Records-and Placements.

DIRECTED OPEN EXERCISE ODX Division: the position of the cone can be set up to 6 ft in any direction from the midpoint of the arena. If the dog NQs in DOE1 it can continue to perform and be scored on DOE2. deductions shall be made if the dog moves after standing without going beyond a 4 ft radius, or if the dog attempts, but does not assume the heel position by the time the handler reaches the ring barrier.

NEW JUDGES: To expedite the approval of new judges, current AKC judges can take a shortened version of the test which focuses on the differences between AKC and ASCA Obedience rules. Judges who are approved judges in AKC, CKC, and UKC will become provisional ASCA judges immediately upon passing the test and the Provisional time frame has been shortened to 45 days.

RALLY

The RALLY Rule Book will include some wording changes to make the stationary exercises more clear and consistent. There will also be a clarification to describe the Back 3 Steps as both the handler and dog backing 3 steps.

FINALS: for Rally finals 5 double Q's are needed from Masters B and Excellent B. For placements, the top 5 combined scores from Masters B and Excellent B will be used.

STEWARDS FOR RALLY NATIONAL TRIAL AND FINALS: each ring will have a minimum of 3 stewards 1 for Gate, 1 for table and 1 as the ring timer, 2 stop watches to be used,.

JUDGES: a change will allow applicants to qualify with either a CDX or ASCA ODX. and the rulebook will be reworded to aid consistency in scoring and penalties.

STOCK

NEW COURSES have been approved for use after June 1, 2016: G+ H are new and the old A and B courses will be bidirectional.

The new rulebook will also clarify Course E with a better description of obstacles 4 and 5.

Newsletter Report: Art Landry stated that submission deadline for the next newsletter is March 15th.

ASCA BOD Report: Pete Dolan announced that elections are coming up and there are five candidates running for the ASCA BOD. The new software program will start June 1st. the 2018 National Specialty will be in Greeley, Colorado. Cindy King reported that there is a meeting in April and if any members would like to send input, send it ahead of time to Calla.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. Exhibitors, through submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of current ASCA rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial, including, but not limited to, the following:

- This trial is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting any signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.
- Dogs are not required to have an ASCA Registration, ASCA LEP, or Tracking number to enter this trial. However, to receive ASCA titling certificates, refer to the next bullet. Handlers do not need to be ASCA members. However, no entry will be accepted from anyone not in good standing with ASCA or any dog/handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program.
- Receipt of ASCA Titling Certificates –

Starting 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a Tracking Number after ASCA qualifying legs have already been earned. The ASCA Membership and Tracking Number Application form is included in this premium. For additional membership information, please go to www.ascne.org.

- Current jump height table, breed exemption list, description of classes, levels, and divisions can be found at ASCA's web site.
- THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site.
