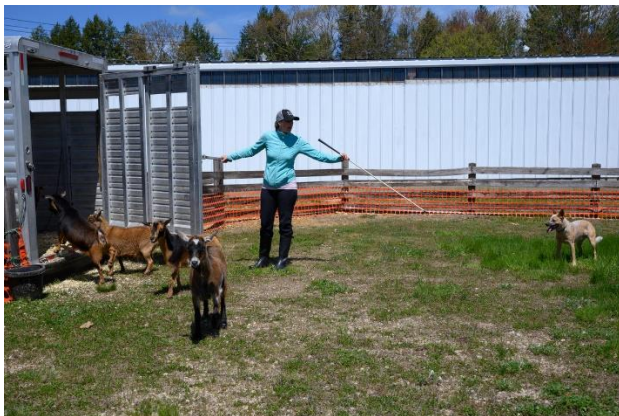

# MEETING MINUTES:

June 23, 2019 ASCNE Membership/Board Meeting

Location: Canine Sports Center 416 Old Middle St. (Rte 63) Goshen, CT 06756

Meeting was called to order by Anne.

1. Treasurer's Report was read by Matt Mason: June 1, 2019 Account Balance \$22,518.11

March Conformation Show: \$1358.37 March Agility Trial: \$604.45

April Ob/Rally: \$ (434.61) May Ob/Rally: \$(91.20) May Farm Trial \$(114.26)

May Agility: \$2501.67 COS Agility: \$2169.02

The question was raised and needs to be confirmed with the treasurer that 2019 donations were made to ASCA Finals and Nationals based upon the amounts noted in the ASCNE Policies at the March 2019 membership meeting.

2. Old Business: A. Reminder that ALL post show/trial/event paperwork needs to be submitted to ASCA and ASCNE within 14 days of the event to avoid ASCA late fees as well as to keep the ASCNE financials current.

B. ASCNE Credit Card update-Reviewed that ASCNE is trying to get a club CC not associated with an individual's name and credit history, which is difficult to establish for a Non-Profit organization. Citizens Bank told Anne last year that it could be done, however they keep requesting more information and specific formats of documents. Anne is talking to Citizen Bank management about this process. In the mean time, members can continue to expect immediate reimbursement from ASCNE for authorized purchases.

C. Recap of 2019 ASCNE events since March 2019:

COS Conformation-one judge was unable to fly in, so flight was refunded. Three out of 5 judges were local. Final numbers were just submitted to Jen and ASCA two days prior to the meeting, so financial status is not known. Turnout of participants was good.

COS Agility-went well. Approximately a \$300 donation was made to ASHGI from a "Tunnelers" event.

COS Obedience/Rally- there were about 100 entries and events went well. Final numbers have not been completed yet.

May Farm Trial in NH-The weekend went smoothly. All three trials were well received and participants enjoyed them. Plans are underway to continue with the FT at NH



Sheep and Wool Festival in 2020. Unfortunately some last minute entry withdrawals secondary to human health issues as well as the judge's flight home being cancelled, resulted in a financial loss. Expenses would have been covered if the rental car for the judge on Monday was not necessary. NHSWGA is supposed to be writing a check to ASCNE to cover the short fall. Matt will continue to pursue that reimbursement.

August Ob/Rally Trial weekend- Still on the schedule. It has a history of being well attended. 2 Rally and 1 Obedience trials are scheduled for Saturday and just 2 Obedience trials are scheduled for Sunday.

HMM: Conformation-2 shows on Saturday and 2 on Sunday. No Friday Conformation show this year.

Stock-Judges have been hired, rooms have been blocked at the Quality Inn.

NOTE: The ASCA Red Roof/LaQuinta discounts were mentioned as being available for ASCA members.

Agility/Obedience/Rally/and Versatility updates not available for HMM

November Ob/Rally-this event has been reduced to being only a 1 day event to minimize expenses

November ASCNE meeting to be held at Good Mojo University in Milford NH. Featured Speaker is Laura Allen who will discuss and demonstrate Search and Rescue training with her Aussies. See the ASCNE calendar for more details.

D. Volunteer Lunch Vouchers-issues arose at COS as to who was given vouchers for lunches and it was unclear as to which activity had issued them. A discussion was held and decision made to have the chair of each activity give out index cards to their volunteers to turn in to the food vendor each day. This practice is intended to improve and smooth out what ASCNE owes to the vendor and clarify which events to assign expenses to on the books.

2. ASCA BOD vote: Members present voted for Pete Dolan, Jan Wesen and Jean Roberts for ASCA BOD positions. Members present also voted Yes for the ASCA By Law Changes.
3. Review of 2020 Calendar:
  - a. January meeting-need to confirm location at Canine Mastery



- b. January Ob/Rally Show-n-Go will also include a Conformation Match
  - c. February 9 will be either an Obedience or Rally Trial. One day only that weekend.
  - d. March ROM Banquet organization needs to be confirmed with Alexis Reidy
  - e. March Conformation Show is scheduled
  - f. April 19 will be either an Obedience or Rally Trial. One day only.
  - g. May 17 will be 2 Obedience and 1 Rally Trial in Goshen CT. NEW DATE.
  - h. May 9 and 10 will be ASCA Farm Trials in NH
  - i. June 6 and 7 COS. Needs a chair for Agility as well as Ob/Rally. Keli Gaunt will do Conformation. Possibility of agility clinic that weekend too.
  - j. July ASCNE meeting needs to be scheduled in June or July. Date TBD secondary to numerous conflicts in that time frame.
  - k. September ASCNE meeting date may move to September 13 to avoid Labor Day weekend travel in 2020.
  - l. HMM will not be held in 2020 secondary to the ASCA Nationals in GA.
  - m. November Obedience/Rally show will be limited to one day, but which day needs to be determined.
  - n. A Chair is needed for the November Agility trial to be held November 14 and 15.
4. Discussed possible herding clinic to be sponsored by ASCNE in 2020 when calendar allows. Matt will look into options.
  5. Keli Gaunt and Alicia Campbell requested consideration for the COS Sunday Conformation show to be considered a "Regional Specialty" to help draw more competitors. There are already two Regional Specialties in NY state each year and this one would potentially be situated between them. A "catalog" would need to be developed based upon pre-entries and a breeder judge would need to be hired. 2019 COS Conformation financials need to be seen first and a budget needs to be presented to the ASCNE BOD before this event can be approved.
  6. A discussion was held regarding having vendors at ASCNE events. They have been welcomed in the past and are still welcomed to be present. A suggestion was made to have them do a nominal donation to ASCNE or to a raffle as payment for vending.
  7. The obedience participants were recently made aware by a judge that a jump is not regulation. The present jump is 8 inches high and it needs to be only 4 inches. Keli Gaunt volunteered to have the jump made if ASCNE covers the cost of materials. Members present voted to approve payment for materials, expected to be less than \$100. Thank you to Keli for organizing this.
  8. Alicia asked if there is a "Sunshine Committee" as there were two situations she knew of that should receive a card. Upon further research, both situations are no longer ASCNE members, so the potential requests were not made. I also reiterated to the members and BOD present that I had requested the Sunshine Committee requests be given to another BOD or club member early in 2018 as I did not have the time or expertise to send off cards in a timely fashion on behalf of ASCNE.
  9. Meeting adjourned. A brief Conformation handling seminar was conducted by Alicia after the meeting. Thank you to both Alicia and Keli who also did a grooming seminar prior to the meeting.

- All dogs competing for ASCA Obedience titles are required to start at Novice and work through Utility regardless of Obedience titles awarded by other Registries.
- ASCA Obedience judges may not enter or handle in the A classes.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
