To keep to our schedule as much as possible, no additions on exam day can be allowed. Your dog may not be taken earlier than your scheduled appointment. The schedule is created by Dr. Bachrach and allows for time for placing eye drops, and double exams for breeds which need an exam prior to placing eye drops.

For official CERF certificate, your dog MUST have either a tattoo or micro-chip number. Please remember to bring your dog's AKC or other registry number.

Dr. Bachrach will have a non-CERF exam report form available if you do not wish an official CERF report; however the cost of the exam is the same.

Directions: From I-90 take exit 5/Everett Rd., turn south toward Central Ave., go to traffic light, turn right onto Central Ave. heading west towards Schenectady. Go 1.3 miles under two RR overpasses, look for Sunset Bowling Lanes on left, then Lee's Market (small green sign on left), turn left onto Kraft Ave. Go 1 block, Good Dog Training Center is directly in front of you.
